Pencil

Ruler

Scissors

Bladed cutting knife (Stanley, scalpel. Very cheap snap off blade types best as they are more flexible)

Glue stick

Paperback book at least 2.5 cm thick

Waste cardboard (cereal box or similar)

A few 'clamps' eg clothes pegs, bulldog clips

magazines, colourful magazine with thin paper – local real estate newspapers are ideal newspaper

hot glue gun (If you have one)

cutting mats if available

paperclips
